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
Navigating Rave's New User Interface

Medidata Rave's global navigation menu allows you to quickly navigate to **Clients** (e.g., Frontier Science), **Study groups** (ACTG-IMPAACT for Classic Rave; FS-ACTG-IMPAACT for Rave EDC), **Studies**, or **Sites**. Studies can be quickly accessed via the Medidata home page via the following:

WEB LDMS VERSION 11.0

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Frontier Science is pleased to announce the release of Web LDMS version 11.0. This version will be deployed to all laboratories in late February 2025. As outlined below, this release includes many new features that enhance user experience and provide additional project support. Additional information regarding this release, including detailed release notes, will be forwarded to all of our end users in the coming weeks.

A Web LDMS 11.0 New Feature webinar training is scheduled for Friday, February 7, 2025 and all end users are welcome to attend. Details regarding the webinar will be circulated soon.

User experience and overall improvement

- An Unavailable Date field has been added:
 - ♦ At the primary and aliquot level
 - ♦ To Custom Report Builder (under the Specimen category)
 - ♦ To Specimen Filters
 - ♦ To Set Condition Code popups and Storage Delete popups
- The Intended Ship Category field will now populate an intended ship date based on selected criteria when selecting the Mark to Ship option
 - Users will now be notified if they have overdue shipments upon login if samples have been marked to ship, but have not been shipped out per the intended ship date
- Drop down customization lists are now in alpha/numeric order.
- Global Specimen IDs will now be listed on error messages when sample errors prevent saving.
- When deleting specimen records, a Reason for Delete text field will now be required.
 - Reason for Delete will display in the New Data column on the Transaction Log report.

Storage

- Global Specimen ID, ID1, and Specimen ID can now be optionally displayed in the storage tree main view and move popups.
- Freezers containing specimens can no longer be deleted.
 - A warning message has been added indicating the number of specimens contained, and that they will be removed from storage when the level/container is deleted.
- Storage Filters have been added to Storage Move popups.



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WEB LDMS VERSION 11.0, cont'd

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Shipping

- Users can override the Import-As-Is box configuration when importing samples.
- Shipping Evaluation:
 - \diamond When a Problem Code is selected, users can choose ID2/study ID values from the available dropdown list
 - ♦ A free-text Comments field is available for each problem code selected
- Shipping Box Positions are now able to be Manually Updated in an Outgoing Shipping Box.
- QA/QC enhancements include:
 - Will refresh when saved
 - Will warn the user if there are unsaved changes when closing the QA/QC window
 - Option to print labels for specimens

Reports

- Standard Reports:
 - A list of Global Specimen IDs can be uploaded for any Standard Report that has a filter criteria of global spec ID
 - User Event Report is an available report under the Admin report category
- New Fields added to Custom Report Builder
 - ♦ Level 1 Position: displays the position that level 1 is assigned within the storage unit
 - Level 2 Position: displays the position that level 2 is assigned within level 1
 - Container Position: displays the position that the container is assigned within either level 1 or 2.
 - ♦ Original Volume
 - ♦ Original Volume Unit

Barcodes and Labeling

"FSQ" control characters are no longer included on 2D generated barcode labels

Testina

- The "Other Specimen ID" of a specimen can be edited from "Pending Test Results"
- "Set Condition Code" feature is available in Test Results

I graduated from Buffalo State University with both a Bachelors and a Masters in Education and worked as a special education teacher for a decade.


How long have you worked at Frontier Science?
